Good Afternoon,

As a result of the extreme & hazardous weather conditions experienced in Southeast Queensland last week, the Forum Samoa II v91 was only able to depart anchorage at the port of Brisbane on 24th May.

The delayed departure from anchorage was necessary in order to ensure weather conditions at sea had abated to a degree that would allow the safe operation of the vessel.

The Forum Samoa II v91 will now proceed to Port Kembla to take on fuel bunkers.

Due to the delayed departure from Brisbane the coastal port rotation has been changed to avoid further delays at Port Botany resulting from port congestion which is now being experienced at Port Botany due to the heavy traffic now arriving from Brisbane with the resumption of departures from Brisbane anchorage.
